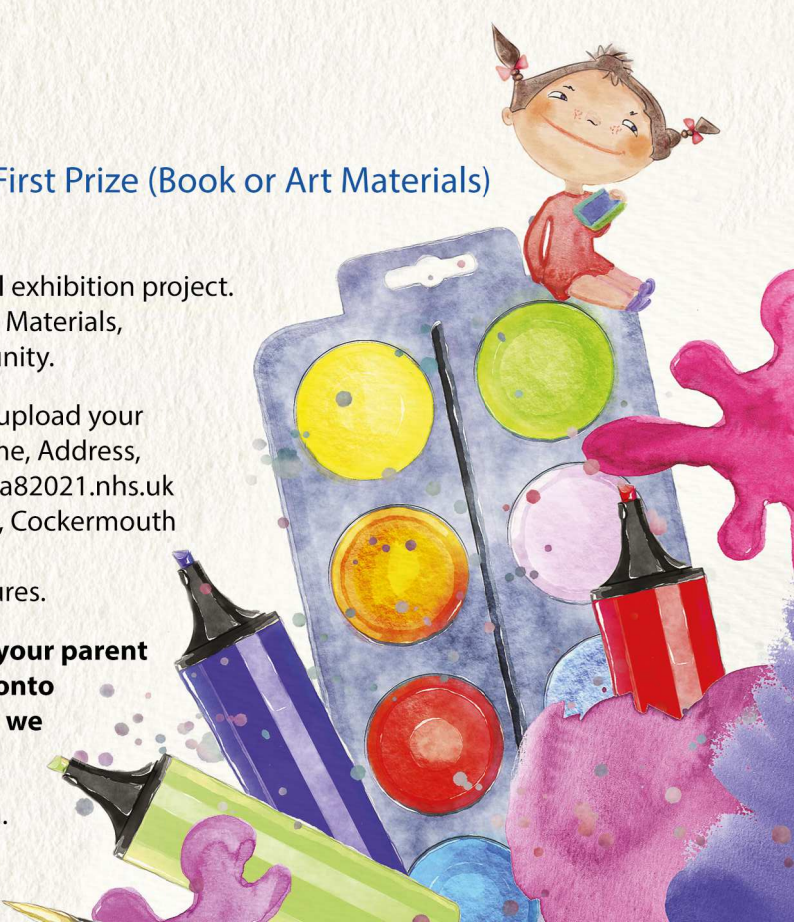
The Winner... from each age category £100.00 First Prize (Book or Art Materials)
